



Announcement of the Anatomy Association of Thailand (AAT)

Subject: Scholarships for AAT Member

The Anatomy Association of Thailand (AAT) aims to promote and encourage members to present high quality of their research in the 6th International Anatomical Sciences and Cell Biology Conference (IASCBC), which will be held on 10-12 June 2020 at the National University of Singapore, Singapore. The AAT then offers the “AAT Member Scholarships” supported by the budget balance of the Anatomy Association of Thailand. Scholarships are awarded based on the potential impact of their research. Scholarship recipients should attend the entire conference.

Scholarship Information:

- There are 10 scholarships.
- Scholarships will be awarded to student who is an AAT member.
- Scholarship recipients are selected by the Scholarship Committee.
- The THB 4,000 scholarship is intended to provide partial support (registration, travel, accommodation) for attending the 6th IASCBC
- One member will receive only one scholarship.
- All scholarship awards are given at the AAT44 Conference. The AAT requires original receipts for expense reimbursement.

Eligibility:

- To be eligible for the “AAT Member Scholarship”, applicants must meet the following criteria:
 - Be an AAT student member
 - Be the first author and the presenter at the 6th IASCBC.
- Submit an application letter to AAT including the confirmation documents of the registration, an abstract or full article, and acceptance letter for presenting at the 6th IASCBC via thaianatomy@gmail.com **within 1st May, 2020.**

- The scholarship awards will be announced on 29th May, 2020.

Requirements:

- Scholarship recipients are required to present their works as given at the 6th IASCBC at the AAT44 Conference.

Criteria:

The Scholarship Committee will take into consideration the following criteria when considering applicants:


- Scientific quality of research
- Being a lifetime ordinary member of the Anatomy Association of Thailand.

Notification:

- The list of Scholarship recipients will be announced at the AAT web page (www.anatomythailand.org).
- Scholarship recipients are asked to make a brief acknowledgement: "I acknowledge the support of the Anatomy Association of Thailand for the scholarship to present this work" in the first or last presentation slide (for oral presentation) and in the poster (for poster presentation).
- Judgment of the Scholarship Committee is considered as a final decision.
